The ninth General Meeting of the International VLBI Service for Geodesy and Astrometry (IVS) will be held during the week of March 13-17, 2016, at Ekudeni (in Muldersdrift, near Johannesburg), South Africa. All IVS Associate Members and individuals who have interests in the application of VLBI in the fields of geodesy, Earth sciences, and astrometry are invited to attend the meeting.

The keynote of the ninth GM is the opening of new possibilities with the VLBI Global Observing System (VGOS) under the theme "New Horizons with VGOS." The VGOS network will gradually develop into its full operational state over the next few years, but even during the transition period from the current S/X network to the higher accuracy VGOS systems, new frontiers in science and applications will be opened up by virtue of the increased coverage with VLBI data of unprecedented accuracy.
